A rosette, jump bar, engraved tray, and neck ribbon will be awarded to all dogs earning an AGCH, MACH, or PACH.

A rosette and jump bar will be awarded to all dogs earning a PAX. (If your dog earns both a PAX and a PACH at the same time, you may choose between one or the other.)

A rosette will be awarded to any dog earning a Bronze, Silver, Gold, or Century title in the Master classes.

All dogs earning a title will receive a New Title rosette.

A ribbon will be awarded to any dog earning a Double Q.

ISC Cup:

There will be cumulative scoring for A2 and J2 rounds with special prizes awarded for the top three teams (value not to exceed \$25) in each jump height (8", 12", 16", 20", 24"). Preferred dogs will be scored within the regular height class.

INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC) CUP

Purpose: The ISC class is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International-style Standard and Jumpers courses. The rules for these classes are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course design is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the “Challenge of the Day” when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent/Master classes. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website www.akc.org.

ISC level description & info:

- A1 (STD 1) and J1 (JWW 1) are the beginning levels of FCI/ISC Courses.
- A2 (STD 2) and J2 (JWW 2) are the intermediate levels of FCI/ISC Courses.
- A3 (STD 3) and J3 (JWW 3) are the master levels of FCI/ISC Courses.

Eligibility: Teams may enter any levels offered!

Jump Heights: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights. However, only those dogs running in the 12”, 16”, 20” and 24” class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualification to enter WTT or EOTT. Please see the EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

Qualifications: “Clean run” scores from ISC classes at the 12”, 16”, 20” and 24” may be used toward fulfilling the minimum requirements for *WTT/EOTT. A “clean run” consist of a run without time or course faults. Minimum YPS requirements are waived for these scores, as long as the dog is under the course time set by the judge for that class. *As of January 2023, Grade 1 clean runs do NOT count toward WTT qualifiers, only Grade 2 and 3.

Obstacles: A-Frame height will be the same as regular AKC trial heights. Per AKC revisions, effective February 1, 2023, FCI style broad jump will be used at this event for the ISC classes.

TMAC’s ISC Cup

- To be eligible to win, teams must be entered in both ISC classes
- A winner will be awarded in each jump height with scores from both rounds combined, (Preferred will be scored within Regular height class.)
- Second and third place will be awarded, as well.
- Opportunity for podium photos after awards.
- Scoring will be time plus faults.
- Faults and refusals are each 5 seconds penalties. Time penalty is 1 seconds for each second over course time. Faults are dropped bars, missed contacts. Wrong course is elimination; 3 refusals are elimination. Teams eliminated in both rounds cannot win or place. Examples: 2 faults (a bar and a contact) and 2 refusals = +20 seconds penalty. 4 faults = +20 seconds penalty. 3 refusals = elimination.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO) – EFFECTIVE 7/1/24

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

FIX AND GO ON

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog’s performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

ADDITIONAL INFO

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendations to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

All owners of **MIXED-BREED DOGS** must obtain an AKC Canine Partners Listing Number before entering an AKC agility event. **UNDER “BREED” ON THE ENTRY FORM, DOGS MUST BE LISTED AS “ALL AMERICAN DOG” AND NOT AS A BREED HYBRID.**

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure any dog entered in the trial. All height divisions will be offered.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will conform to those listed in the current edition of the AKC *Regulations for Agility Trials*.

ENTRY FEES: FOR ONLINE ENTRIES, GO TO WWW.PAWPRINTTRIALS.COM. FOR MAIL-IN ENTRIES, MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO PAWPRINT TRIALS. **\$25.00** for the first entry per dog per day; **\$25.00** for the second entry of the same dog each day; **\$20.00** for the third entry of the same dog each day; **15.00** for each additional entry of the same dog each day. Junior Handler entries are discounted \$10.00 per run when AKC Jr. Handler number is listed on entry. Entry fees include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 per run.

CLOSING DATE: **Saturday, July 19, 2025 at 6:00 p.m.**, after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 14 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

WAIT LIST: There will be a wait list (maximum 75 runs) to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial closes on Saturday, July 19 at 6 p.m. Entries withdrawn BEFORE the trial closes on Saturday, July 19 at 6 p.m. will receive a full refund. Entries withdrawn after trial closes on July 19 at 6 p.m. but prior to Saturday, July 26 at 6 p.m., will be replaced with an entry from the waitlist if one is available. Any withdrawn entry replaced by an entry from the waitlist will receive a refund subject to a \$5.00 processing fee. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Saturday, July 26 at 6 p.m. will receive a refund.

MOVE-UPS & CANCELLATIONS: In order for move-ups and cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. *If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received.* No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgement.

REFUNDS: After entries close, refund requests for bitches in season will be accepted when accompanied by a veterinarian's note. An administration fee of \$5.00 will be withheld. Refund requests must include a veterinarian's note and be received by the trial secretary no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class of the day. There will be no refund for injury or illness after entries close.

SITE INFORMATION

TRIAL REGULATIONS - NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS must pay by international money order or credit card.

TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

EVENT COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. See "Refunds".

DOGS PARTICIPATING must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners Listing, or be approved FSS breeds eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided the listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial is open to All American dogs.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE will be made when entries are processed for those exhibitors that provide an email address. Confirmation notices including the judging schedule will be sent to all exhibitors no less than seven days prior to the event.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
